**\*\*\*\*\* West Nile Virus \*\*\*\*\***

Health Canada continues to stress that the risk of being bitten by an infected mosquito is low. To prevent the breeding of mosquitoes, we ask that you clean up all areas around your homes where mosquitoes can breed, such as holes in your yards, or bird baths where water accumulates and becomes stagnant.

While outside during these mosquito months, cover up with light colored, long sleeved shirts and pants when mosquitoes are most active between dusk and dawn, and use insect repellents that are federally regulated such as those that contain DEET.

These small steps can make a big difference in keeping us healthy.
