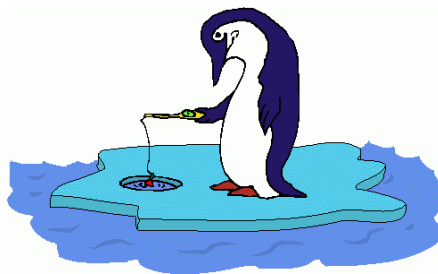
**ADMISSION:** \$50.00 per hole per person.

Effective April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010, any stray dogs picked up by the Dog Catcher will now be transported to the McGarry Dog Pound in Virginiatown. The Township of Larder Lake will be charged \$125.00 for each day a dog/cat is impounded in the McGarry Dog Pound and this fee will be charged to the pet owner. Therefore, the owner of the animal that is impounded will be required to pay to the Township of Larder Lake \$125.00 for each day the animal is impounded plus the \$50.00 fine **before** he/she is able to claim his/her pet from the McGarry Dog Pound. The Township of Larder Lake will transfer to the owner of the pet any costs associated with any Veterinary services, adoption or disposal fees, which may be incurred or required for any dog that the Township of Larder Lake brings to the McGarry Animal Shelter.
