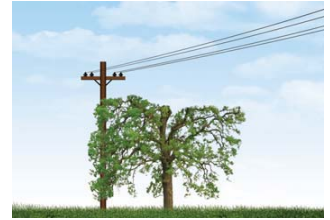
***** Summer Land Fill Hours *****

***** **Right Tree, Right Place** *****

Hydro One is asking that before you plant trees or shrubs on your property, make sure you are planting the right tree in the right place. Locate overhead and underground power lines, check the maximum growing height and plan the proper planting location. ***** **Ontario Family Fishing Week - July 3rd to July 11th** *****



If you or someone you know would like to try fishing in Ontario waters for the first time (or the first time in a long time), circle the week of July 3-11, 2010 on your calendar. For those nine days only (12:01 a.m. Saturday to 11:59 p.m. Sunday), Canadian residents can enjoy the fun of fishing in Ontario without a licence during the annual Ontario Family Fishing Weekend.

This licence-free period is designed to remind people of the recreational and economic value of Ontario's recreational fishery, and the importance of sustaining and enhancing it for future generations. Anglers must still abide by the limits set for the **Conservation Licence** and all other fees and regulations apply and will be enforced, including size limits and sanctuaries. ***** **The Bears Will Be Back** *****

The nice weather has finally arrived and will be bringing out the bears along with it. In order to keep our community safe we must all take an active role and participate with the following. Here are a few tips that may be helpful while trying to keep the bears out of our community.

As per By-law 1234-08 **all residents** are required to:

- Put your garbage out only on the morning of Garbage day.
- Use bear resistant garbage containers with a secure lid.
- Store your garbage in a shed or garage to minimize smell.
- Thoroughly clean outdoor B.B.Q. grill after use.

***** **Fire Permits & Fire Pits** *****

Fire officials are predicting a high fire hazard in the 2010 summer season with the lack of precipitation that has been received during the past winter and in the recent weeks. Therefore all residents are reminded that By-Law # 1211-08 requires **all residents wishing to burn debris to obtain a fire permit from the Larder Lake Fire Department.** Residents are also reminded that in the event of a fire ban that is proclaimed by the Ministry of Natural Resources all fire permits are cancelled.

All residents who wish to have a campfire in their back yards should do so using an approved Outside Fire Pit or Outside Fireplace and they should be inspected by the Larder Lake Fire Department. ***** **Reminder To Larder Lake Residents** *****

We ask that all dog and cat owners please remember to keep your pets on a leash, and when walking your animal we ask that you carry a bag to pick up after your pet while off your property. Council wishes to advise that if owners do not comply, that a By-law will be passed and fines levied for anyone not picking up after their pet.

All residents should be reminded that due to concerns regarding safety and cleanliness at the beach, dogs are not allowed anywhere in the public beach area.

******* Important Notice Regarding Emergency Telephone Calls *******
