******* A Message From Your Reeve *******

OFF ROAD VEHICLES

Your council has permitted off road vehicles to drive on township streets for the purpose of accessing bush trails. **NOTE: This is a privilege, not a right!**

Due to some people abusing this privilege, I have listed a few of the 38 Regulation 316 of the Highway Traffic Act:

- Hwy 66 not permitted
- Hwy 624 only on shoulder
