

NOTICE TO LARDER LAKE RESIDENTS

Students who are 14 years and older have the option of participating as part of their volunteer community service requirement for high school credit, or to get paid for hours worked.

All participants please assemble at the Fire Hall at 9:00 a.m. Saturday May 3rd to register. Volunteers are asked to bring work gloves and bristle brooms if possible.

SPRING CLEAN UP WEEK May 3rd to May 10th.

- Brush should be cut in 36 inch lengths and tied into bundles
- Steel and wood products should be placed into different piles so we can separate this waste accordingly for landfill purpose.
- Yard waste should be put into containers or garbage bags no more than 35 pounds each.
- **NO CONSTRUCTION WASTE** will be picked up; this includes materials such as boards, roofing materials, drywall etc.

Please note: Large appliances such as stoves, fridges, washers and dryers will only be picked up on Thursday May 8th. Please do not put these appliances out until the night before this date.

Landfill hours will be extended during Clean up Week as follows:

Tipping fees WILL NOT be waved on construction material.
