All residents are reminded that during the April 2008 Municipal Council Meeting By-Law # 1211-08 regarding open burning was passed. Please be advised that all residents wishing to burn debris **must** obtain a permit from the Larder Lake Fire Department. Residents are also reminded that in the event of a fire ban that is proclaimed by the Ministry of Natural Resources all fire permits are cancelled.

All residents who wish to have a campfire in their back yards should do so using an approved Outside Fire Pit or Outside Fireplace and they should be inspected by the Larder Lake Fire Department.
