## Winter Parking on Streets

Please be advised that from November 1<sup>st</sup>, 2008 to April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2009 residents are asked not to park on the streets from 12:00 midnight to 7:00 a.m. All vehicles are to be parked inside the Township pole lines and the owner’s property. Should we be required to do plowing at these hours, we will have your vehicles towed away at the owner’s expense. The Township also wishes to advise residents that during daytime hours when the Works Department is snow plowing the streets, any vehicle parked on the street interfering with the snow plowing, and the flow of traffic, will also be towed at the owner’s expense. We would greatly appreciate your cooperation by not parking on the street when there is a snow storm.

## Winter Snow Removal

The Township would like to remind all residents that it is an offence to put snow from your property onto town streets. Anyone caught putting snow on the streets will be charged with littering. It is suggested that you contact the local snow removal contractors to have your snow hauled away to avoid any obstructed view on corners and driveways. The Township of Larder Lake would appreciate everyone’s cooperation in this matter.
