Recycling

Residents and Businesses of Larder Lake and Dobie Township, welcome to your new Curbside recycling program! Your recycling bin will be delivered to your residence within the next couple of weeks. Your first recycling collection day will be Tuesday September 30th 2008 and will continue every other Tuesday. You can put your recycling on the curb on that morning with your garbage. If you have a serious physical disability you may put your recycling out at your front door where it can be seen from the road. If you are in need of an extra bin you may request one from the town office. A few simple things to remember before you begin to use your new recycling bin are:

1. Follow the list below of what can and cannot be recycled.
2. Rinse all recycling before dropping it in the bin.
3. Break down cardboard boxes and tie it together if you have too much of it to fit in your bin.
4. Bag any shredded paper you may have in a clear plastic bag.
5. You do not need to sort your recycling, it can all be mixed in your bin.
6. Remove lids from plastic bottles.
7. Do not put compost material in your bin.
8. Do not put your recycling out the night before as it will attract bears.

Recyclable Materials Include:

- PAPER PRODUCTS – newspapers, magazines, computer paper, pamphlets, flyers, envelopes, writing paper, cardboard, boxboard, cereal boxes, old corrugated cardboard, tissue boxes, soup boxes and shoe boxes, etc.
- ALUMINUM /STEEL CANS - used for food and drink
- GLASS JARS AND BOTTLES – used for food and drink
- PLASTIC CONTAINERS – bottles and all other plastic containers with the following symbol.



NON-Recyclable Materials Include:

- PAPER – such as wax paper, paper towels, juice boxes, milk cartons, waxed grocery boxes
- METAL – such as spray cans, paint cans, coat hangers, batteries, metal pots and pans, aluminum foil and plates
- GLASS – such as drinking glasses, cups, dishes, window glass, light bulbs, mirrors, pottery, glass pots and pans, make up jars
- PLASTIC – such as dishes, caulking tubes, motor oil jugs, make up containers, pails, cellophane, and all other plastic material which **does not** have the #1 or #2 recycling symbol.

Please keep this sheet as a reference. A successful recycling program is only as good as those who participate. Please do not hesitate to call Eco-Logix or the town office to ask questions about your new curbside recycling program or visit the eco-Logic website to email your comments or questions. There will be a large bin placed at the dump to collect recyclables. You can bag your recycling and place it in the bin and the contents will be picked up on collection days.

The Ministry of Natural Resources has advised us that the Spiny waterflea has established itself in the Larder Lake. Please help to prevent the spread of this creature to other water bodies.

- Remove ALL plants and animals from boat, trailer, anchor, fishing gear, especially downrigger cables and dive gear.
- Flush engines and dispose of bait, bilge water and bait bucket water on land away from shore
- Thoroughly dry boat and all gear prior to use in another body of water.
- Never release any plant or animal into a body of water, unless it came out of that body water.
- Dispose of all foreign matter far from water.
