Please be advised that construction will begin for the Sixth Avenue Water & Sewer Replacement Project on Monday, September 21st, 2009 and is expected to be complete before November 30th, 2009.

Residents may have already noticed that Pedersen Construction Inc. has already begun to prepare for the work to take place.

In order to complete this work with minimum disruption to the households in the affected area measures are being taken to provide each household with a temporary water line. These temporary water lines will be located above surface on the affected property.

Residents in the area should experience a minimal disruption to the traffic flow as well as access to their driveways.
